Stony Creek Energy, LLC is proposing to construct a wind-powered generating facility consisting of up to 59 General Electric 1.5xle, or equivalent, wind turbine generators ("WTGs"), each with a maximum height of nearly 400 feet, which includes an operation and maintenance (O&M) facility, a system of gravel access roads, a 34.5 KV electrical collection system of buried electrical cable from the 59 WTG(s) to a substation, and one 262 foot permanent meteorological tower.

- A. the Project may have potential impacts to soil, through disturbance (temporary and permanent) as part of the Project, including erosion, disturbance of steep slopes, blasting and other impacts to shallow bedrock;
- B. the Project may have potential impacts to water quantity and quality through impacts to the groundwater resources, including but not limited to existing water supply wells/springs, surface waters, streams and wetlands;
- C. the Project may have potential impacts to vegetation and wildlife through the removal of existing vegetation as part of the construction activities and maintenance during the operation of the Project;
- D. the Project may have potential impacts to natural resources, including, but not limited to, threatened or endangered species, as well as bird and bat populations through the operation of the Project;
- E. the Project may have potential visual and aesthetic impacts in that each of the 59 wind turbines will be approximately 400 feet in height at the highest point of the blade, in addition to the motion and shadow flicker that results from the operation of the Project;
- F. the Project may have impacts on historic and archeological resources;
- G. the Project may have potential sound impacts associated with both the construction and operation of the Project, including, but not limited to low frequency noise during operation of the Project;
- H. the Project may have potential impacts on communication signals through interference such as signal obstruction, attenuation or other signal alteration;
- I. the Project may have potential traffic and transportation impacts during the construction of the Project;
- J. the Project may have an impact on the growth or character of the community or neighborhood;
- K. the Project may have an impact on agricultural land resources; and
- L. the Project may have an impact on human health through the shadow flickers and/or noise associated with the Project.

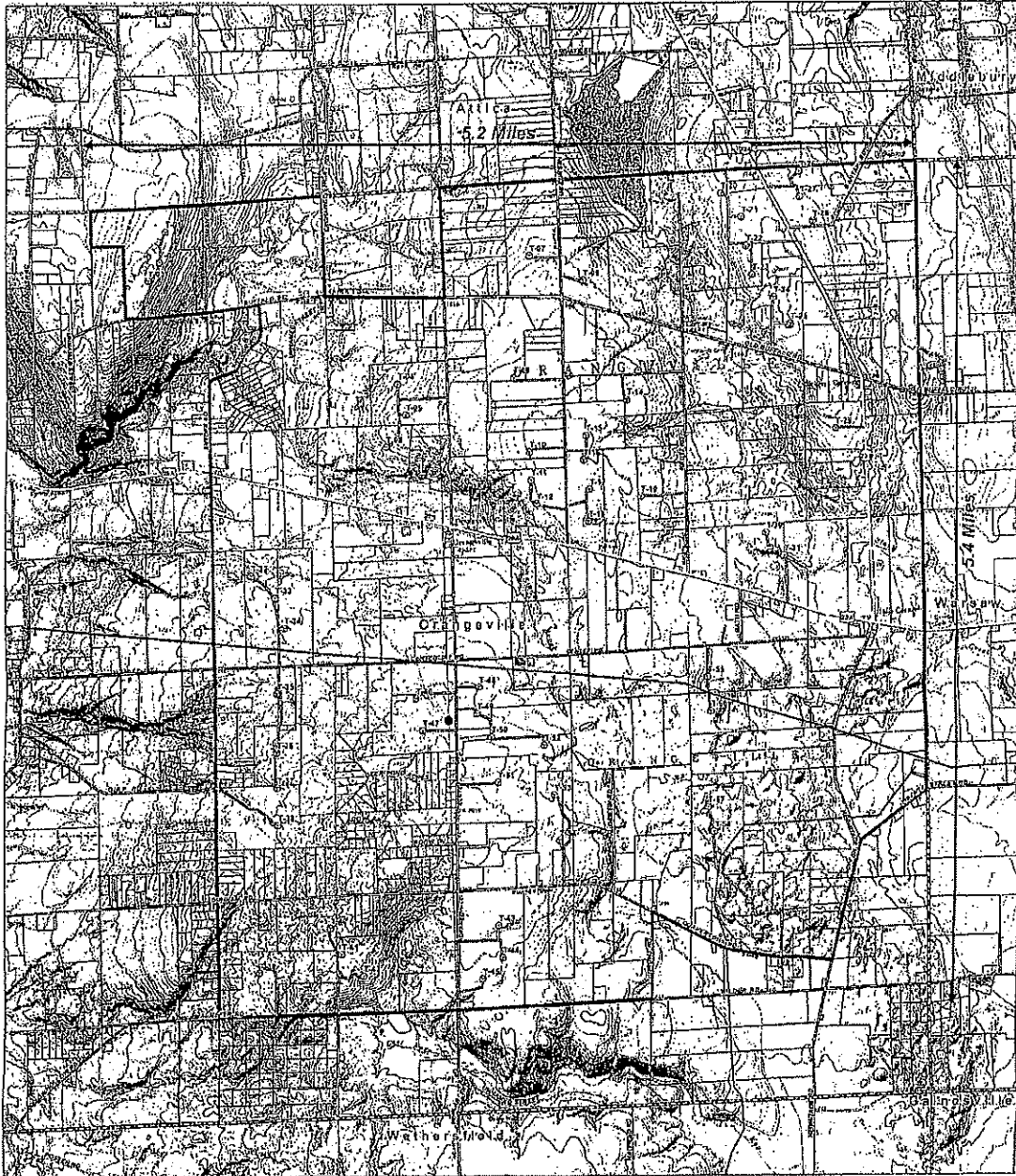
